Refrigerators and stand-alone freezers must be in working condition and must be between 10 and 30 cubic feet using inside measurements. Customers may earn an additional \$25 for recycling a room air conditioner or dehumidifier along with a qualifying refrigerator or freezer. Ohio Edison, The Illuminating Company and Toledo Edison (FirstEnergy's Ohio utilities) contract with Recleim, an appliance recycler, to pick up and recycle the units. Customers must own the units being recycled. Limit two large appliances and two small appliances per residential and small commercial address per year. Your incentive will be sent within 4 to 6 weeks after appliance collection. Additional restrictions apply. Your participation in these programs reduces demand for electricity, which results in energy efficiency resource credits being created.
