These three words can help
you stay safe around electricity.



Winter weather can bring electrical safety hazards, including downed power lines. If you ever see a power line down – or anywhere but strung between two poles – call 911 immediately and follow these three simple steps to avoid dangerous accidental contact with electrical equipment:

STOP Stay at least 30 feet away. Electricity can travel through anything it touches, including the ground.

LOOK for a safe location and call 911 immediately.

LIVE Always assume power lines are energized and dangerous.
