Attend an upcoming Energy Assistance Day where representatives from New Jersey Natural Gas and state-designated agencies will guide you through the eligibility and application process for energy assistance. Income guidelines are higher than you may expect. A family of four making up to \$141,384 may qualify. Income-eligible households may also qualify for home energy-improvement programs to help manage energy bills.

- Social Security cards
- Proof of income for all household members 18 years and older
- Government-issued ID for applicant
- Deed or rental lease
- Recertification form (if applicable)
- Recent natural gas and electricity bills
