Contributions to the PAC will be used for political purposes and are not reimbursable by FirstEnergy Corp. You must be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident to contribute. The maximum legal contribution is \$5,000 per individual in a calendar year. Federal law requires the PAC to use its best efforts to collect and report the name, address, occupation, and employer of each individual whose aggregate contributions exceed \$200 in a calendar year.
